Ordinance & Description	Outcome
● ORD 22-2025 - An ordinance enacting a new chapter 773 “recreational marijuana” of the business regulation code.	Passed as an emergency 5-0.
● RES 35-2025 - Authorizes the Mayor to apply and accept a community program grant through NOPEC.	Rules suspended. Passed as an emergency 5-0.
● RES 36-2025 - Grants letter of intent for purchase of ambulance.	Rules suspended. Passed as an emergency 5-0.
● RES 37-2025 - Enter into an agreement to purchase a 2025 Jacobsen LF-550 fairway mower. Needed as our old fairway mower is 21 years old.	Rules suspended. Passed as an emergency 5-0.
● RES 38-2025 - Fees and Rates for Glaneagles Golf Course	Rules suspended. Passed as an emergency 5-0.
● RES 39-2025 - Settlement agreement with Matthew Pfeifer and Ohio Patrolmen’s Benevolent Association.	Rules suspended. Passed as an emergency 5-0.
● RES 40-2025 - Land swap agreement between TCSD and City of Twinsburg.	Read for the first time. Great discussion during Caucus meeting.
● ORD 41-2025 - Authorizing destruction of city property as it would cost more to make sellable.	Rules suspended. Passed as an emergency 5-0.
