- Jonah Pichette spoke as a proponent of Ordinance 53-2025. This ordinance would change the parking ordinances in the City to prevent parking on the hydrant side of street, allow the Mayor to enact emergency snow bans, and prohibit parking on specific streets. - Council met in Executive Session to TO DISCUSS MATTERS PURSUANT TO OHIO REVISED CODE § 121.22(G) (2) TO CONSIDER THE PURCHASE OF PROPERTY FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES, THE SALE OF PROPERTY AT COMPETITIVE BIDDING, OR THE SALE OR OTHER DISPOSITION OF UNNEEDED, OBSOLETE, OR UNFIT-FOR-USE PROPERTY IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 505.10 OF THE REVISED CODE, IF PREMATURE DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION WOULD GIVE AN UNFAIR COMPETITIVE OR BARGAINING ADVANTAGE TO A PERSON WHOSE PERSONAL, PRIVATE INTEREST IS ADVERSE TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC INTEREST.
