

I am already looking forward to next year and making it an even bigger and better event!



Annual Shred Day

It's that time of year again, The City of Twinsburg's annual Shred Day is coming soon! Mark your calendar for Saturday, June 14th, 9am-12pm at the Twinsburg Public Works building (10231 Ravenna Road). Residents of the City can bring up to six boxes or bags of paper material to be shredded onsite, and later recycled. This helps support the mission of the Environmental Commission, and protect you in the process. A few quick reminders, please remember paper should **not** be pre-shredded, your boxes or bags should **not** have anything except paper in them.

Construction Continues

The Broadway/Richmond/Macedonia Rd project kicked off on April 1st. The first phase of construction will be between Richmond Road and Pettibone Road.

During this first phase, traffic will be maintained in the northbound direction (heading out of Twinsburg toward I-271). Southbound traffic will be detoured via eastbound Pettibone Road and southbound Richmond Road. The project is expected to be expansive. Current completion ETA November 2025.
